Introduction

How are your typing skills? Are you a quick or a slow typist? Do you make many mistakes or few? The typing test you completed gives insight into this. Good typing skills are required for many positions.

Of course there are different requirements for each job: sometimes you are required to type very fast and accurately, while at other times, basic typing skills suffice. Your test results are given below: your typing skills score (total score), your typing speed (strokes per minute), and your accuracy (percentage of correct entries). Your total score is based on the combined scores for speed and accuracy. We use the following categories:

Weak: Your typing speed is below 100 strokes per minute OR your typing speed lies between 100 and 150 and your error percentage is higher than 3%.

Moderate: Your typing speed lies between 100 and 150 strokes per minute and your error percentage is maximum 3%. Or you type (much) faster, but make (many) more mistakes.

Basic level: Your typing speed lies between 150 and 200 strokes per minute and your error percentage is maximum 3%. Or you type faster, but your error percentage lies between 3-6.5%.

Expert level: Your typing speed is higher than 200 strokes per minute. Your error percentage is below 1%.
